**Schedule:** Registration at 8:00 a.m. Shooting begins at 8:30 a.m.

**Location:** 5720 Old Camp Road, Bell City, LA This is the SW Louisiana Rifle & Pistol Club range

on LA Hwy 27 at Holmwood, LA. (1/2 mile South of the intersection where LA Hwy 14

splits from LA Hwy 27)

**Entry Fee:** \$15 (includes NRA registration fee). Entry limited to 30 competitors. Entry closes at 9:00

a.m.

Eligibility: Tournament is open to the public. NRA membership is not required. If under 18, you

must be accompanied by a parent or guardian.

Rules: Current NRA rules for Action Pistol Shooting shall apply.

**Firearm** Open, Metallic Sight, Production, Production Optic (Centerfire)

**Divisions:** Open, Metallic Sight, Production (Rimfire)

Classification: NRA Action Pistol Classification will be used. Shooters that are unclassified in any

discipline will compete in a separate Unclassified Category. Rule 19.6- Assigned

Classification, or Rule 19.4 Temporary Classification may be used.

**Equipment:** Revolvers and semi-automatic pistols compete together. **Eye and ear protection is** 

mandatory for all shooters and spectators.

Minimum Caliber is 9mm. Ammunition must meet a power factor (bullet weight times velocity) of 120,000. It is suggested you bring a minimum of 300 rounds of ammunition. In accordance with Rule 3.12, holsters must be practical, safe, serviceable, and suited to the pistol used. Holsters must retain the pistol during any activity within a course of

fire. No cross-draw holsters will be allowed.

Rimfire guns may be used but will compete only against other rimfire shooters and will

be eligible only for overall rimfire category awards.

**Courses:** The tournament will consist of an aggregate of four of the events listed below:

Practical Event; Barricade Event; Moving Target Event (Mod.); Falling Plate Event; Ambidextrous Match; Speedload Challenge; Crawford Barricade Event, International

Rapid Fire, Texas Mover

**Targets:** Rule 4.2: NRA AP-1 cardboard targets will be used in turning target mechanisms on the

paper events. Rule 4.3: 8" diameter round steel plates, .375" thick will be used in the Falling Plate Event and the Ambidextrous Match. In the event of a failure of range

equipment, back-up timing will be accomplished using a timer.

Competitor's Duties:

Each competitor will be required to act as safety officers and scorers for the alternate relay of their assigned squad. Plug-type scoring gauges shall only be used by the Chief

Range Officer or Match Director.

Range Rules:

Pistols will be permitted on the range only when holstered or cased. Practice draws and sight pictures will be permitted only at the firing line and at the direction of the Range Officer. A Safe Area will be provided for cleaning and repair. No live ammo will be permitted in this area. Violation of this rule will result in disqualification. There shall be no handling of firearms except on the firing line or in the safe area. You may, while at your vehicle, transfer your unloaded pistol from its case to your holster and vice versa. This is the only gun-handling allowed in the parking area.

Facilities:


The range is equipped with a portable toilet. There is no running water. You should bring your own food and drink. *No alcoholic beverages area allowed on the premises.*

Directions to Range

Range address for use with GPS: 5720 Old Camp Road, Bell City, LA This is the address to be used with GPS; the range entrance is actually located at Holmwood on Old Camp Road 800 feet west of its intersection with LA Hwy 27 at Holmwood, LA.

From Lake Charles, exit I-210 at LA 14; follow LA 14 approximately 10 miles to Holmwood; continue straight, now on LA, 27 ½ mile to Old Camp Road (look for a white sign with a red bullseye.) Turn right onto Old Camp Road, and then right at sign "5720"

From East of Lake Charles, exit I-10 at exit 36; go South on LA 397 to LA 14. Turn left and head East on LA 14, toward Holmwood, and follow the directions above.
