Entries limited:

Entries are limited to 40 competitors.

Post entries: Post entries will be accepted the day of the match up to the stated limit of the range, provided such entries will not require a special relay.

Squadding: All matches will be squadded. Squadding tickets will be available the evening prior to the day of the match. cards, LSA membership, and classification cards must be exhibited when picking up squadding tickets. Failure of a competitor to present himself at the proper firing point when his relay is called may lose his right. to compete in that event.

Classification: CMP classification system will be used. There will be two categories, Civilian and Service.

Challenges: A fee of \$3.00 will be charged for each challenge made. See CMP for the correct procedure.

entries after combining all categories, there will be no awards in that class and the class will be moved to the next higher class. No individual will be given more than one award in a single match. An individual winning a match shall not be entitled to a category/class award. Such awards will be passed down to the next competitor. Winners will be given for each match. Category and class awards will be given for each fired match on the following basis:

RULES: This match will be governed by the rules prescribed by the Civilian Marksmanship Program.

OPEN TO: Any citizen of the United States 16 years of age or older. (Distinguished personnel are eligible to compete, however, if range facilities limit the number of entries that can be accepted, priority will be given to non-Distinguished competitors.

COURSE OF FIRE: National Match Course

First Stage: Slow fire, 50 yards, B6 target, one ten round string, ten minutes

Second Stage: Timed fire, 25 yards, B8 target, 2 strings (5 shots each), 20 seconds per string

<u>Third Stage</u>: Rapid fire, 25 yards, B8 target, 2 strings (5 shots each) 10 seconds per string

FIREARM: Pistols allowed as described in 2022 CMP Competition Rules and Regulations, section 6.3

AMMUNITION: Any safe ammunition is allowed as described in 2022 CMP Competition Rules and Regulations, Chapter 4.

Competitors will be required to furnish their own ammunition.
